-Cannock, Staffordshire

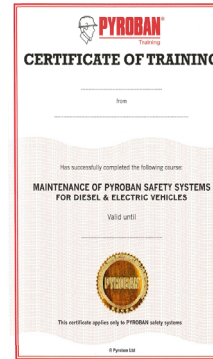
Prior knowledge

Experience of fork lift truck engineering and maintenance is essential.

Course certification

Notification and issue of certificate, if applicable, will be sent by post no later than 7 working days from course end date to the person responsible for booking the course.

The certificate is valid for two years. To revalidate the course will have to be retaken in full.
